Deep down inside we know we have a little bit of Peter in us somehow in small ways our lives betray Him from time to time.

This idea that Peter and the prodigal son are cut from the same cloth resonates with me. The prodigal in all of us, like Peter wants to be faithful but sometimes we just can't manage it. As we journey through these days of holy week there will be different resonances because of the way we're celebrating this year. The trial for us isn't whether we can be faithful to the Lord as He stands trial before Pilate or as He's condemned to death, but if we can stay faithful as we face these trials, if our lives can continue to say, "Yes we know the man".
